Applicant must comply with all pertinent regulations listed below:

- **Section 5.2.8.1: Definition Portable Storage Container:** *Any container larger than 600 cubic feet designed for the temporary storage of personal property which is typically rented to owners or occupants of property for their storage use and which is delivered and/or removed by truck trailer.*
- **Section 5.2.8.2:** *No person shall place a portable storage container in private property without first obtaining a zoning permit from the Land Use Officer. A zoning permit fee is required with the filing of the permit.*
- **Section 5.2.8.3:** *There shall be no more than two (2) portable storage containers placed on an individual property at any one time. Portable storage containers shall not exceed eight (8) feet in height or 160 square feet in size.*
- **Section 5.2.8.4:** *Portable storage containers shall be placed only in the driveway and be set back a minimum of ten (10) feet from the front property line. No portable storage container shall remain at a site in excess of 14 consecutive days from date of permit.*
- **Section 5.2.8.5:** *Portable storage containers used in conjunction with a construction or remodeling project which has a valid building permit **must be removed within (150) days of permit issuance** and/or within ten (10) days following the final inspection or issuance of the certificate of occupancy.*
- **Section 5.2.8.6:** *Portable storage containers shall not be permitted for use as a detached, permanent storage building, utility building workshop, hobby shop and other similar purposes as defined under Section 5.2 Accessory Structures in Residential Zones.*
