

Prospect Town Council
Special Meeting on the Purchase of Community School
Approved Minutes
November 9, 2015

Chairman Thomas J. Galvin called to order the Special meeting of the Prospect Town Council @ 4:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Prospect Town Hall, 36 Center St., and began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Special Meeting was held for the Council to set a Public Hearing to move forward with the purchase of Community School. T. Galvin stated that Regional School District 16 had accepted the Town of Prospect's proposal of \$873,000.00 to purchase Community School. The Town's Attorney, John Yarbrough and the Region's Attorney are conferring and have not set a sales agreement at this time. Mayor Chatfield advised that he would prefer to wait on the Public Hearing until all costs were set in place and a sales agreement was made. After discussion, it was the consensus of the Council to wait until the sales agreement was reached and the next steps of the Region were noted before a Public Hearing could be set.
