Chairman Thomas J. Galvin called to order the regular meeting of the Prospect Town Council @ 8:20 p.m. The meeting was held at the Prospect Town Hall, 36 Center Street and began with the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was taped.

\$190,000.00 paid to correct leaking roof at Community School. Lightning struck Community School with approximately \$5,000.00 worth of damage that the insurance company will cover. Several dead trees were cut, windows washed, plumbing corrected. All floors have been done. Separations established for the portables for sports equipment. Sprinklers and fire extinguishers will be installed. Fiber-optics will be installed for Wi-Fi to when used as a storm shelter. The Insurance Inspector, Fire Marshall, and Building Inspector will walk through the school to give their consent before the school is open.
