

LAST DAY TO PAY TAXES EXTENDED FROM FEBRUARY 1, 2021 TO APRIL 1, 2021

On December 16, 2020 Governor Lamont enacted Executive Order 9R which extends the last day to pay the taxes that become due January 1, 2021 without being charged interest from February 1, 2021 until April 1, 2021. Any January 1, 2021 payments received after April 1, 2021 that do not contain an official US Postmark will be charged interest at a rate of 1 ½ % per month from January 1, 2021.

LANDLORDS ARE SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDED FROM EXECUTIVE ORDER 9R UNLESS AN APPLICATION IS FILED WITH THE TAX COLLECTOR ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1, 2021.

Executive Order 9R does not include taxes that became due prior to January 1, 2021. Interest on payments due prior to January 1, 2021 will be charged interest at a rate of 1 ½% per month from the due date.

Any questions regarding Executive Order 9R should be directed to the Tax Collector's office. The tax office is staffed Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The tax office will be closed December 24th, December 25th, and January 1st. The tax office will be closing at 12:00 Noon on December 31st.
